Zinc die-cast pump head with solid steel pump. High-volume, low-pressure output for filling auto chassis lubrication reservoirs

Central lube coupling supplied with spare plug-in adaptor.

ASSEMBLY

Note: Numbers in brackets refer to item numbers on the parts diagram.

- 3.1. Pass the pump (1) through the adaptor (3) fitted to the lid (4).
- Tighten the clamp on the adaptor (3).
- Fit the unit to a bucket of grease, securing the lid by using the three fixing screws (5).
- The unit is now ready for use.
