2. INTRODUCTION


Features smooth 25mm ball bearing drawer runners, side handle, cylinder lock and, for additional security, rear locking bars to secure drawers when not in use. Supplied with two keys.

3. ASSEMBLY

- **3.1.** Attach the castors to the bottom of the trolley (fig.1) using 4 bolts and washers per castor.
- Note: The swivel castors should be mounted on the same side as the side handle (left hand side).
- **3.2.** Insert the side handle into the cabinet with four bolts and washers (fig.2).

4. MAINTENANCE


4.1. Lubricate the castors and check the castor fixings periodically.
