2. INTRODUCTION

Rigid steel construction suitable for safe movement and storage of steel and plastic barrels. Cradle fitted with two smooth rolling, heavy-duty Ø150mm wheels and one Ø75mm castor wheel. 2-position handle locks upright or at 45° and features tools for 5 different drum caps and a metal drum tilting attachment.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. Position the trolley in front of the drum.
- 3.2. Remove the handle from the trolley and use it to tilt the drum.
- 3.3. Push the trolley cradle under the tilted drum.
- 3.4. Refit the handle to the trolley and transport drum.
